



## MARAAI ROSÉ

### TASTING NOTES

This pink dry wine has strawberry and gooseberry aromas on the nose with a rich and fruit-forward texture in the mouth. A refreshing summer drink.

### IN THE VINEYARD

Situation: Banghoek Valley - East and North-South Facing Row Direction

Altitude: 350m

Distance from sea: Approximately 23.5km

Soil Type: Gritty sand, scree covering granite, deposits of weathering products of granite

Age of vines: 5 - 12 years

Trellising: Vertical hedge

Pruning: Cordon

Irrigation: Drip

### HARVEST

Picking date: February

Yield: 8 tons/ha average

### IN THE CELLAR

The grapes were de-stemmed and crushed. The juice was immediately pressed and cold settled for 2 days at 8°C. Thereafter the clear juice was racked off its lees and inoculated. After fermentation, the wine was left on the fine lees in stainless steel tanks for 3 months.
